



Maricopa Community Colleges Foundation

- In 2011-2012, 2,642 scholarships and program grants at a value of 2.6 million dollars were awarded. The average scholarship amount was \$665.
- Since 1987, the Maricopa Community Colleges Foundation has awarded more than 21 million dollars in scholarships.
- 3.1 million dollars in gifts from more than 2,200 donors were received by the Maricopa Community Colleges Foundation in 2011-12 and 85 new funds were created.
