## Information Session Declaration Concurrent Enrollment Programs (CEP)

The Concurrent Enrollment Associate-Baccalaureate (or Associate-Master's with Grand Canyon) Nursing Programs are offered through MaricopaNursing and participating university partners. These programs are designed to allow qualified nursing students to take nursing courses with an identified university partner to earn a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) degree while pursuing the Associate of Applied Science (AAS) in Nursing. Students with a previous bachelor's degree may begin coursework toward a Master of Science in Nursing (MSN) degree through Grand Canyon University while pursuing their AAS.

Applicants must meet admission requirements for MaricopaNursing and the identified CEP university partner. Students who are selected for admission to the program pursue an AAS degree in nursing at their "home" MaricopaNursing College while concurrently taking required university courses.

## To learn more about CEP options and the application process:

- 1. Refer to the MaricopaNursing website for general admission requirements. If eligible for admission, students must complete and application for admission to MaricopaNursing.
- 2. Review program brochures for CEP partners, which are available on the MaricopaNursing website. Admission requirements, costs, and program delivery vary between university partners; therefore, students are encouraged to compare programs to determine the best fit for their needs.
- 3. Review the CEP information presentation located on the MaricopaNursing website. This short presentation provides an overview of CEP program details. Students may elect to attend an in-person CEP information session offered at various MaricopaNursing campuses throughout the year.
- 4. See a nursing advisor to help develop your personalized pathway to becoming a registered nurse. Campus nursing advisors are knowledgeable about MaricopaNursing and CEP options. Be sure to bring a copy of your unofficial transcripts and HESI A2 scores when meeting with an advisor.
- 5. When all eligibility requirements are met, submit the CEP application. Complete all areas of the application, review and sign the declaration page. (*Note: CEP applicants must have a current application in the MaricopaNursing database*).
- 6. Completed applications are to be submitted to the nursing advisor at the MaricopaNursing College of first choice. Applications are accepted December 1 through January 31, (summer university start) and April 1 through May 31, (fall university start).
- 7. Following the CEP application intake period, all applications are uploaded to the system. This takes approximately two weeks following the final day of application submission. Nursing Directors review all applications and send acceptance letters according to rubric scores until all available CEP seats are full. This process takes approximately two additional weeks. Emails notifying prospective CEP applicants of program denial go out approximately 6 weeks following the final day of application submission.
