****ATTENTION! There is a new process for turning in a CEP Application at PC Nursing** Please read carefully.**

All students applying for the CEP will turn in your completed application to a designated drop box located at the Center for Nursing Excellence 3700 N. 3rd Ave, Phoenix, AZ 85013. There is no appointment needed to submit your application. You simply drop your application in to the locked drop box. There will be no advisor or staff person available to answer questions. Student is responsible to meet with an advisor the semester before applying.

CEP application must include the following four (4) items, no exceptions:

1. CEP Application
2. Signed Declaration page
3. **All Unofficial transcripts from all institutions (including Maricopa colleges) Must include University Transcript Evaluation completed by Phoenix College**
4. HESI A2 scores
