



Next Steps for the Student Who Failed the Paramedicine Computer-Based Entrance Examination

A passing score of 70% (raw=105/150) on the Paramedicine computer-based entrance examination allows you to proceed to the next step in the in the Paramedicine selection process. However, if your score is less than 70% (raw=105/150), you have failed to achieve the accepted minimum score. Follow these steps to continue in the Paramedicine selection process:

STEP #1 IF YOUR SCORE ON THE FIRST ATTEMPT ON THE PARAMEDICINE COMPUTER-BASED ENTRANCE EXAMINATION IS LESS THAN 70%(raw=105/150)

If your score on the first attempt is less than 70% (raw=105/150), you can schedule a second attempt of the entrance examination **after a minimum of 30 days from the date of the first attempt.**

STEP #2 IF YOUR SCORE ON THE SECOND ATTEMPT ON THE PARAMEDICINE COMPUTER-BASED ENTRANCE EXAMINATION IS 70% (raw=105/150) OR HIGHER

If you pass the second attempt with an 70% (raw=105/150) score or higher, you can proceed to the next step in the in the Paramedicine selection process: **Complete and Submit the MCCCDC Paramedicine Program E-Application** and subsequent steps in the selection process.

STEP #3 IF YOUR SCORE ON THE SECOND ATTEMPT ON THE PARAMEDICINE COMPUTER-BASED ENTRANCE EXAMINATION IS LESS THAN 70%(raw=105/150)

If your score is less than 70% (raw=105/150) on the second attempt, contact the Paramedicine Director at your preferred program to discuss additional options available to you.
