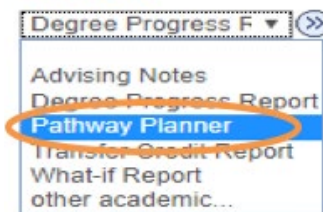


New Student Pathway Planner Tool

What is the Pathway Planner?

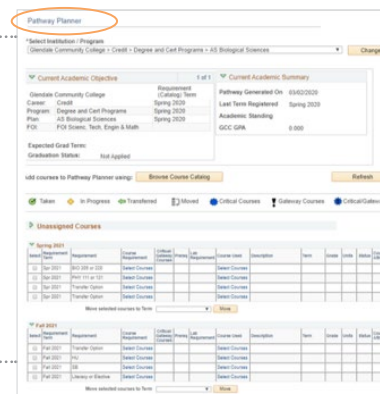
The Pathway Planner allows you to view a pre-populated semester-by-semester course sequence (*also known as a pathway map*) based upon your declared plan in your Student Center. Reviewing your academic plan and degree progress regularly will help you achieve your end goal of graduation.

You can **navigate** to the Pathway Planner by signing in to your [Student Center](#) using your MEID and current password. Then, select "Pathway Planner" from the drop-down menu located under your Academic History Header and click on the >> button.

The Pathway Planner will populate if the plan has a sequence created for it in your Student Center. The pathway map will be auto displayed in a fall and spring semester course sequence, but can be customized by you and/ or your advisor to utilize summer semesters as well based upon your individual academic planning needs.

Benefits for Students!

- You can view your pathway map from your first semester to graduation.
- You can keep track of degree progress by viewing what courses are needed, in progress and completed for your declared plan in your Student Center.
- You can use the Pathway Planner as an academic planning tool in collaboration with the Degree Progress Report to ensure all graduation requirements are met!
- You can customize the pathway to fit your goals and plans for enrollment.



Reading the Pathway Planner

It's important for you to learn how to read and navigate this new tool in order to use it properly. Below is a snapshot of one semester in the Pathway Planner. A more detailed How-To Reference Guide can be found by going to my.maricopa.edu/pathway-planner-guide.

The **Requirement Column** lists the required courses for your plan. If this column has multiple courses listed, you will need to select the course(s) that you plan to enroll in the Course Requirement Column.

Course Used: This section will list out the courses' used for the requirement based upon courses taken at students' home college, transfer credit, test credit, other credit.
